THE NEED IN THE GREENVILLE BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the five counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic means 88,740 people may face hunger.
- 29,400 are children.
- 21,650 seniors live at or below the poverty level.

- In fiscal year 2019-2020, the Greenville Branch distributed 11,827,378 pounds of food and partnered with a network of 120 agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to more than 9,856,148 meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated 30,000 hours.
