THE NEED IN THE GREENVILLE BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the five counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic means **88,740** people may face hunger.
- **29,400** are children.
- **21,650** seniors live at or below the poverty level.

GREENVILLE FAST FACTS

- In fiscal year 2019-2020, the Greenville Branch distributed **11,827,378** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **120** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to more than **9,856,148** meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **30,000** hours.
