THE NEED IN THE DURHAM BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the six counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Durham,
 78,420 individuals live in food-insecure households.
- 24,490 are children.
- 25,164 seniors live at or below the poverty level.

DURHAM FAST FACTS

- In fiscal year 2021-2022, the Durham Branch distributed **17,065,929** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **148** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to more than 14,221,608 meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated 32,913 hours.
