# THE NEED IN THE GREENVILLE BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the five counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Greenville,
  59,850 individuals live in food-insecure households.
- 22,730 are children.
- 22,541 seniors live at or below the poverty level.

### **GREENVILLE FAST FACTS**

- In fiscal year 2021-2022, the Greenville Branch distributed 14,789,809 pounds of food and partnered with a network of 103 agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to more than 12,324,841 meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated 19,370 hours.
