THE NEED IN THE RALEIGH BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the ten counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Raleigh,
 213,890 individuals live in food-insecure households.
- 72,290 are children.
- 69,807 seniors live at or below the poverty level.

- Volunteers donated 73,827 hours.
