# THE NEED IN THE RALEIGH BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the ten counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Raleigh, **213,890** individuals live in food-insecure households.
- **72,290** are children.
- **69,807** seniors live at or below the poverty level.

## RALEIGH FAST FACTS

- In fiscal year 2021-2022, the Raleigh Branch distributed a record **37,996,351** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **210** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to **31,663,626** meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **73,827** hours.
