THE NEED IN THE SANDHILLS BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the four counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Sandhills,
 35,730 individuals live in food-insecure households.
- 12,450 are children.
- 14,053 seniors live at or below the poverty level.

SANDHILLS FAST FACTS

- In fiscal year 2021-2022, the Sandhills Branch distributed 8,663,324 pounds of food and partnered with a network of 59 agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to 7,219,437 meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated 7.893 hours.
