THE NEED IN THE WILMINGTON BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the four counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Wilmington,
 66,800 individuals live in food-insecure households.
- 16,240 are children.
- 31,443 seniors live at or below the poverty level

WILMINGTON FAST FACTS

- In fiscal year 2021-2022, the Wilmington Branch distributed 9,954,138 pounds of food and partnered with a network of 76 agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to 8,295,115 meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated 6.929 hours.
