## THE NEED IN THE DURHAM BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the six counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Durham, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic means **118,290** people may face hunger.
- **35,920** are children.
- **24,199** seniors live at or below the poverty level.

- In fiscal year 2019-2020, the Durham Branch distributed a record **16,424,810** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **216** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to more than **13,687,342** meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **38,000** hours.
