THE NEED IN THE RALEIGH BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the ten counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Raleigh, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic means **324,660** people may face hunger.
- **116,140** are children.
- **65,881** seniors live at or below the poverty level.

- In fiscal year 2019-2020, the Raleigh Branch distributed a record **36,662,907** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **340** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to **30,552,423** meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **68,900** hours.
