THE NEED IN THE WILMINGTON BRANCH SERVICE AREA

- In the four counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina at Wilmington, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic means **93,950** people may face hunger.
- **27,320** are children.
- **24,735** seniors live at or below the poverty level

HOW YOU CAN HELP

WILMINGTON FAST FACTS

- In fiscal year 2019-2020, the Wilmington Branch distributed **10,703,067** pounds of food and partnered with a network of **98** agencies (including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens, and group homes).
- This equates to **8,919,223** meals for those in need.
- Volunteers donated **9,000** hours.

EFFICIENCY
